Appendix 1. AKI staging based on AKIN criteria

AKI staging	Definition based on GFR	Definition based on urine out put
Stage 1	At least 0.3 mg/dl increase in Scr or increase in SCr $\geq 1.5 \times$ baseline	Urine output <0.5 ml/kg per hour for 6 h
Stage 2	Increase in SCr $\geq 2 \times$ baseline	Urine output <0.5 ml/kg per hour for 12 h
Stage 3	Increase in SCr $\geq 3 \times$ baseline or at least 0.5 mg/dl increase in patients with baseline Scr more than 4 mg/dl	Urine output <0.3 ml/kg per hour for 24 h or anuria for 12 h

AKI= acute kidney injury; SCr= serum creatinine; GFR= glomerular filtration rate
