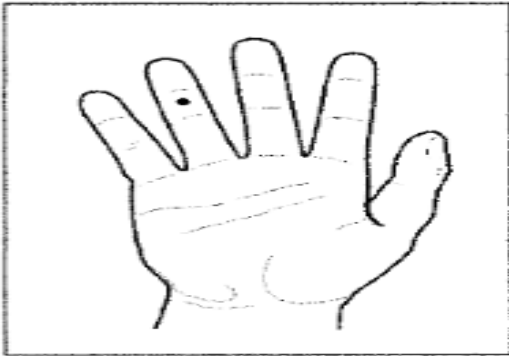


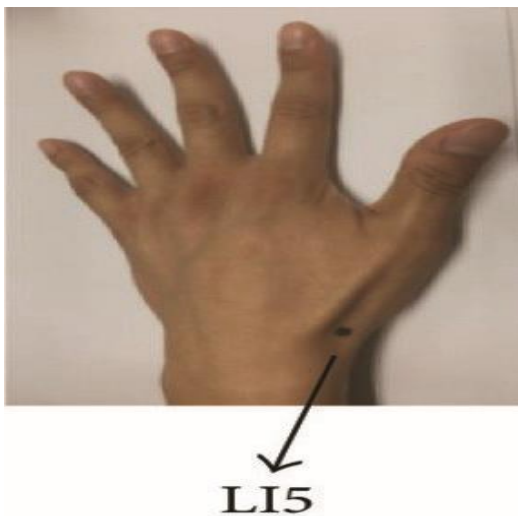
Appendix 1. P6 point (1)



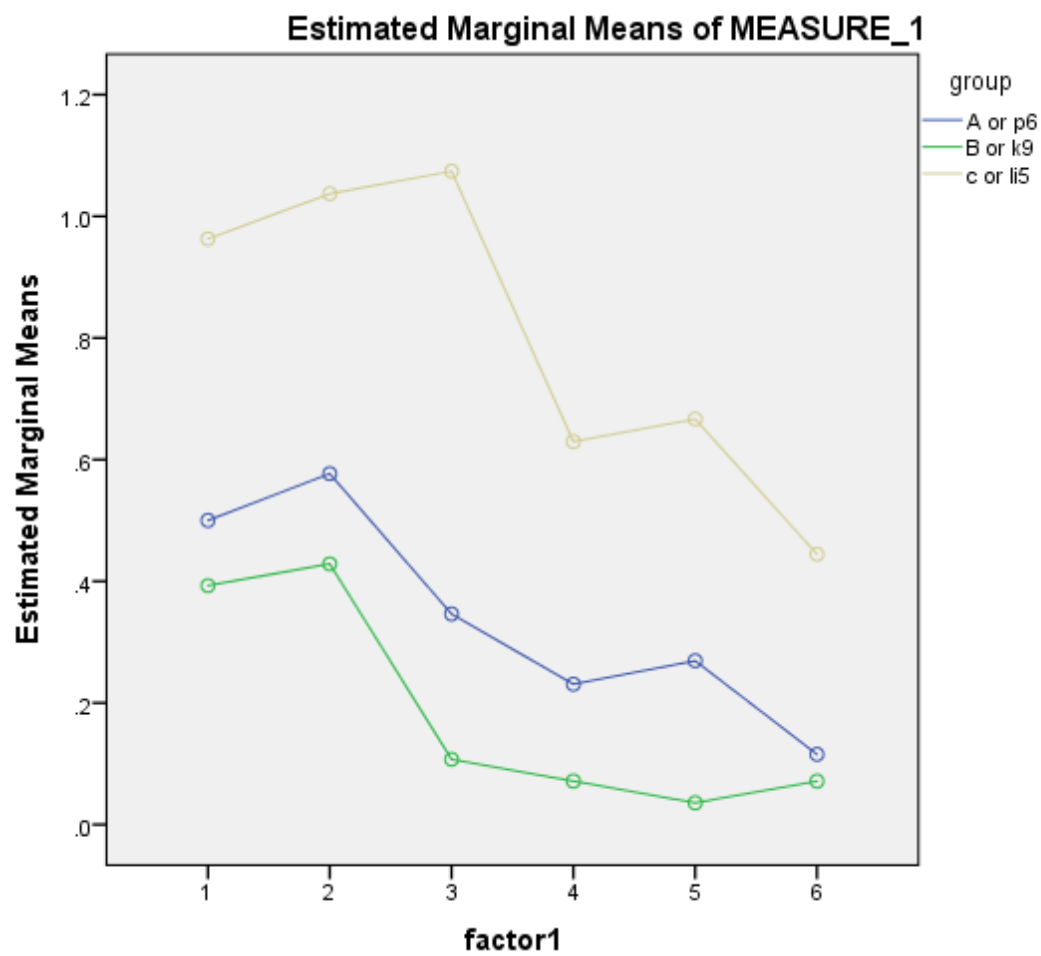
Appendix 2. Point K-K9 (2)
